
No somos nada

After years of silence, the legendary Basque band La Polla Records is making a surprise return to the stage. Evaristo Páramos, the band's charismatic vocalist, announced it at a press conference.

A lot has happened since La Polla Records took the stage for the first time in 1979. Evaristo reminisces from his village punk skin, as he prepares for the trip. His story is entangled with songs, photographs, fragments of animation and old videos of the band. A thousand and one gigs, pitched battles, chases, races, and a ball of sharp, fast music that grew into a myth.

La Polla Records, the living history of the end of a century, now packs its backpack and returns to the stage to say goodbye forever.

For many, the name Malvinas/Falklands evokes an absurd war between England and Argentina in 1982. For Julieta Vitullo, the protagonist of this film, this tragic history becomes deeply personal 25 years later when she suffers a loss associated with her search to uncover that past, unfolding into a life-affirming struggle for renewal and rebirth. This film tells the story of two trips, one made in 2006 and the other in 2010. In the space between one trip and the next, between past and present, between the public and the private, between what can and cannot be told, the movie reflects on the possibilities of conveying extreme life experiences.








Retrodans






Street out



As the legal advisor of the Lapacho Mocho community, as part of the family now, he works to obtain Qatu's freedom, a member of the Wichi community who has been in jail for 5 years waiting for an oral hearing on a charge of abusing his wife's daughter.





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
