Concept Format: 30-minute outreach program in which anonymous people tell us a personal story in a different outdoor location.

Everyone has a story that deserves to be told. In this program we will know those stories told by those who lived them in first person. The common thread will be the set itself on which they are placed to tell their story. It is a traveling set, very minimalist, just composed of a carpet, a bedside table and some decorative elements that reinforces the story that is going to be told.

The landscape itself completes the set, as it is never repeated, thus helping to create a geographical portrait of the environment in which the stories are told.
